

GUIDE TO SCECHS



Michigan School Counselors are required to earn 25 hours in career exploration, of which 5 hours must be in military options, as well as 25 hours in college preparation and selection* every 5 years as part of the total 150 hours of required professional learning.

The career exploration, including military, and college preparation professional development requirement is back in effect now that EO 2020-35, which temporarily put these requirements on hold expired.

ASCA U Specialist Trainings for SCECH Credit

School counselors can enroll in any of the ASCA U courses which can be completed virtually at your own pace. The Career Development Specialist and the College Admissions Specialist courses fulfill Michigan's requirement for career exploration and college admissions and selection PD.

Upon completion of the course MSCA members can complete the SCECH request form and pay \$15 per course with a check made out to MSCA mailed to PO Box 473 Schoolcraft, MI 49087 or pay online.
